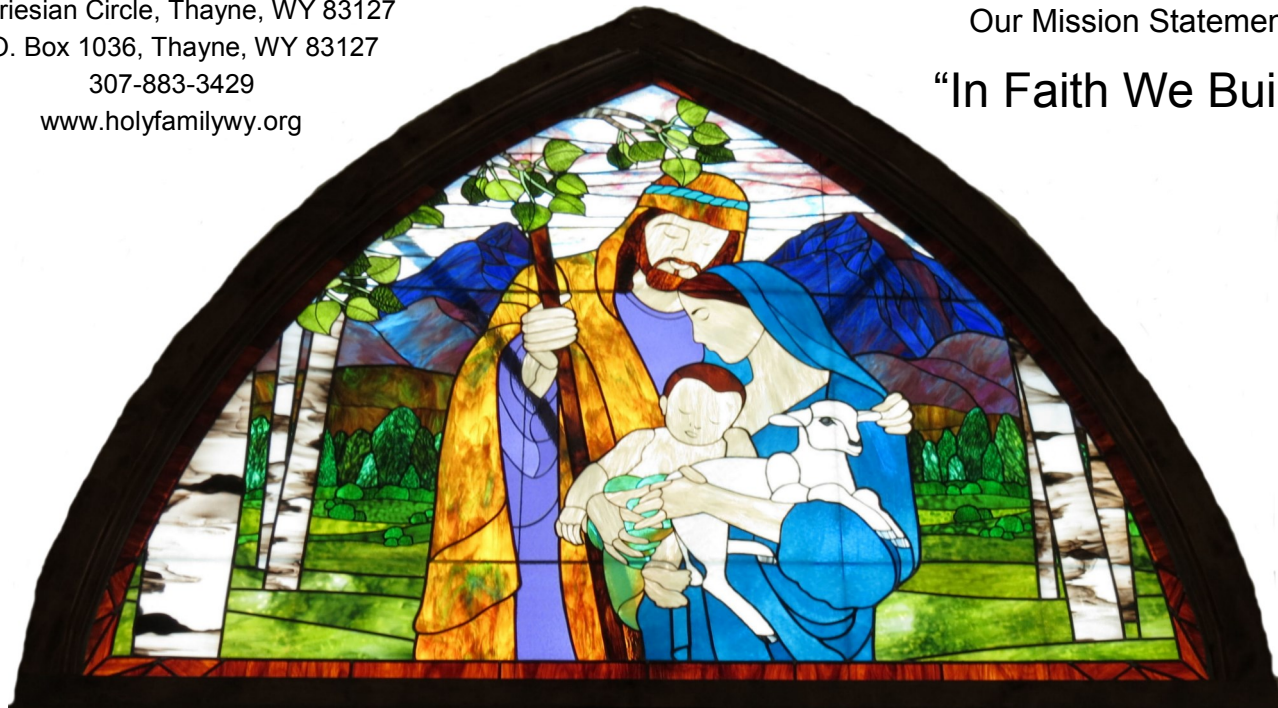

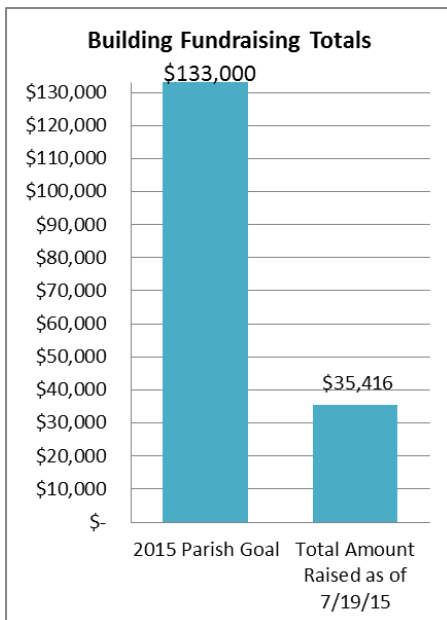

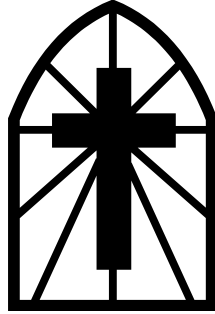

PROGRESS ON CORPUS



Donations and very generous parishioners have resulted in enough money to purchase a life-size corpus and have a cross constructed locally. We have not made any purchases as of yet, as we are still researching what is available within our price range and what would look the best in our sanctuary. We are looking at a life size (5-6 ft) corpus for the cross. The cross would be in the 14 - 16 foot range. Current discussion is that a colored corpus would probably look the best in the sanctuary, but we are asking that parishioners take time to make their ideas known. We are not in a rush, but would like to get 2 or 3 “final decisions” for people to look at. Input and ideas, concerns and criticisms, and general guidance are gratefully appreciated.
