# Newer Wish List Update

It has been a very busy few weeks with lots of things happening and items being crossed off the wish list.

**#1 Priority** has been debt reduction and the congregation has responded with incredible generosity. Although the initial goal of \$133,000 seemed somewhat unreachable, we are currently past \$41,000 in donations along with moving forward on meeting our goal for Living and Giving in Christ, the Diocesan Appeal at the same time.

We have received donations for a new **crucifix** for the sanctuary and have located a crucifix which meets our size and space requirements and our budget! It is pictured below. Please let us know what you think.

A new credence table has been moved into the sanctuary and the old table is used to hold missalettes in the southwest corner of the nave (seating area).

Fr. Beavers mentioned on the 9th of August before Mass that he would like to participate in the design of the new, larger **highway sign**. He also mentioned that he would like to make a substantial donation to the cost of the sign. He would also like the current sign retained and moved closer to the Church. We are looking for a volunteer to assist the good Father in his endeavors and move the project along.

The bathrooms in the classroom area are **complete** and efforts are focusing on finishing minor project in the classroom area.

The classroom access, front walkways, and landscaping have been prepared for the concrete placement which should occur in the next few weeks.

We are preparing to enter our database into our ParishSoft software in the next month. We will be asking for members who are not registered to do so in order to get our records complete and most importantly, current.

Some new seating has been donated to the **sanctuary** area.
